Paymaster Report:

Doug Forsythe presented the paymaster's report and reported that all bills have been paid and the business account is up around \$45,000 indicating we are doing extremely well financially. A motion to receive the report subject to audit was made by Tom Tanner and seconded by Larry Samples. The motion passed.

Tom Tanner said he has attempted to contact Jim Miller without success.

Pat Powell was injured in a fall enroute to tonight's meeting. He injured his head and is home under observation.

Report of Officers:

The open house and rededication were a success with plenty of good food, though attendance was not as high as hoped. Bob McGonigle, chaplain of VFW Post 287, provided the invocation.

Jerry Myers (Golf Committee): said he plans to put the leftover white bag items, which include several golf outings and hotel rooms, on-line with suggested bids and a cut off date. We also have to decide where to hold the golf tournament next year. French Creek Country Club has been suggested. It was pointed out that the Applecross Country Club has been very generous to us. The Commandant said that we held the tournament in August because we have few events in that month.

Good of the League:

Following that ceremony, we will move to the grave site of Sgt. John F. Mackie, the first Marine awarded the Medal of Honor during the Civil War for a second ceremony. Uniform is a short sleeve white shirt and the red satin jacket.

The Beirut Memorial Ceremony will be held on Sunday, 10/24/2021 in Philadelphia at 10:00 AM.

Marine Memorial Sunday will be held on 11/7/2021 at 10:00 AM in West Chester at General Smedley Butler's gravesite.

On 11/10/2022, we will muster at Independence Hall in Philadelphia at 8:00 AM where we will join Les Rouse in hoisting a thirteen-star flag. After this ceremony, we will march to Washington Square Park where we will lay a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown soldier of the Revolutionary War and play taps. From there we will break off and reassemble at the Friends' Meeting House at 4th and Arch Sts., and have another ceremony honoring Major Samuel Nicholas, the first Commandant of the Marine Corps. Joining us in attendance will be representatives of the USMC, Department of Pennsylvania Marine Corps League and other MCL detachments.

The thirteen-star flag will be taken down and folded at 4:00 PM.

On 11/10/2021, the Lionville Middle School is having their Veterans assembly at 8:00 AM.

Also in November, we will have a Veterans' Day ceremony at Kerr Park in Downingtown at 10:00 AM on 11/11/2021.


